
- 2- Run the .dmg file, and finish the installation.
- 3- The **System Preferences** page will open up.
- 4- Click on the **Kerio Sync Connector** icon



- 2- Run the downloaded file, and finish the installation.
- 3- Open Entourage, and select Tools, and then click on Accounts.
- 4- Double click your Account, to open it up
- 5- Make sure that the Exchange Sever box has the **https://mailhost.esudo.com** because we are using SSL Certificate.
- 6- Also make sure that **This DAV service requires a secure connection (SSL)** is selected.
- 7- Press OK to finish.
- 8- Close Entourage, and then reopen it.
